one God, now and for ever. Amen.

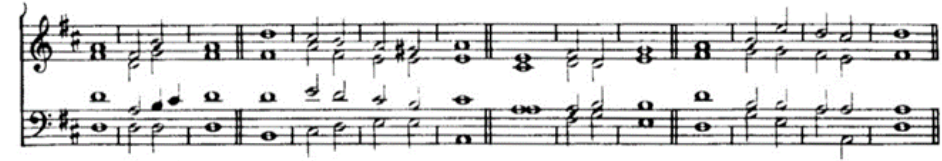
